OUR MISSION

The Ben Hogan Foundation is dedicated to honor, celebrate and preserve the legacy and character of Ben Hogan through support of organizations that promote the game of golf and charities that reflect Mr. Hogan's core values.

OUR INITIATIVES

Established in 2007, the Ben Hogan Foundation focuses its resources and support on five fundamental areas of interest:

- **PRESERVING MR. HOGAN'S LEGACY**

The Foundation's leadership will always ask the question, "What would Mr. Hogan have done?" when making key decisions and determining the beneficiaries of its funds. The Foundation's executive director will entertain requests to meet with clubs and organizations across the nation to increase awareness of the newly established foundation, discuss the wonderful programs it supports, and share real stories about Ben Hogan, an American legend.

- **PROMOTING THE GAME OF GOLF, ESPECIALLY AMONG YOUNG PEOPLE**

We sponsor The First Tee, which provides educational programs that promote character development and life-enhancing values through the game of golf. We are also the principal sponsor of the annual Ben Hogan Junior Invitational at Shady Oaks Country Club, Hogan's home golf course. Young golfers from around the country receive instruction, play with top PGA and LPGA tour professionals, swing Hogan's golf clubs, and learn about Hogan's character, integrity, work ethic, and inspirational life story.

- **FURTHERING CHILDREN'S HEALTH AND WELL-BEING**

Our support helps to send children with acute asthma to Camp Broncho, a program of Cook Children's Medical Center and Children's Medical Center of Dallas. The children camp, hike, fish, play outdoors and experience just being a kid for a week. In addition, these kids will learn more about their disease and how to best manage it. As the Foundation grows we plan to deepen our support for Cook Children's Medical Center and extend our help to other organizations that make a difference in children's health and welfare.

- **PROVIDING COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS**

In 2008, the Ben Hogan Foundation will begin its partnership with the North Texas PGA Junior Golf Foundation by providing Ben Hogan scholarships to deserving youth. In this program, eligible participants need only to play golf -- skill level is not part of the selection criteria. In line with the Ben Hogan Foundation's mission, participants are selected based on academic performance, financial need, extracurricular activities, and an essay developed as part of the application process.

- **SUPPORTING THE MILITARY**

Mr. Hogan served in the Army Air Corps and always greatly respected those who serve our nation. In honor of Ben Hogan, the foundation pledges support for Patriot Golf Day, a fundraising program of the Folds of Honor Foundation and Wounded Warriors, Inc. that supports families of servicemen and women injured or killed while protecting our nation.

LISA D. SCOTT, PRESIDENT, TREASURER AND BOARD MEMBER

Scott is Ben Hogan's great niece, manager of Hogan Licensing and the principle family member responsible for his estate. Following the death of Hogan and his wife Valerie, Scott made significant contributions of Hogan memorabilia to the World Golf Hall of Fame in St. Augustine, Florida, the United States Golf Association (USGA) in Far Hills, New Jersey, and numerous other organizations and institutions involved in preserving the legacy of Hogan and furthering the game of golf. In 2004, Scott authorized and supported the biography of Ben Hogan titled, "Ben Hogan – An American Life," written by James Dodson. Scott is a graduate of University of Southern California and has worked in the movie industry as a digital production manager. Scott lives with her husband and three children in Pacific Palisades, California.

MICHAEL R. McMAHAN, VICE PRESIDENT, SECRETARY AND BOARD MEMBER

As a young boy, McMahan became enamored with Ben Hogan while watching him play in the Colonial National Invitational Golf Tournament. Family trips were scheduled around Hogan's pursuit of major championships. As a member of Colonial Country Club's Historical Committee, McMahan assisted with the design and construction of the club's Ben Hogan Room and contributed many of the items on display. McMahan is a member of the Exhibit Designers and Producers Association, and his company, En-Genuity, designed and constructed the Ben Hogan office at Colonial. In addition, he assisted the USGA with the creation of the Ben Hogan Room at Golf House in Far Hills, New Jersey, and coordinated the loan and return of Hogan memorabilia to the World Golf Hall of Fame in St. Augustine, Florida. He is also a member of the United States Golf Collectors Society and Shady Oaks Country Club (SOCC). McMahan and his wife reside in Fort Worth.

MICHAEL D. WRIGHT, VICE PRESIDENT AND BOARD MEMBER

Wright has the unique distinction and honor of being Ben Hogan's PGA Club Professional. At the age of 23, Wright was personally selected and recommended by Hogan to become the head golf professional at SOCC where he has served in various key positions for more than 23 years. In 1993 and 2001, Mike received the North Texas PGA's Bill Strausbaugh Award for service in the employment and club relations area. Wright has received numerous other awards from the PGA of America, culminating in his selection as the PGA Professional of the Year of the North Texas chapter in 2004. Wright is very active in the North Texas PGA and in the Fort Worth community, and is currently on the Board of Directors for the First Tee of Fort Worth. Wright is married with two children.

DAVID J. CHAPMAN, BOARD MEMBER

Since meeting Ben Hogan in the late 1980s, Chapman has become one of the most knowledgeable individuals regarding the golf legend. Operating from the West Coast, Chapman is a successful real estate developer, restaurateur and investor. In 1997, he developed the Tradition Golf Club and land development project In La Quinta, California and now serves as its President. Chapman is also a partner in the Los Valles Golf Club and land development project; a master planned golf course community in Los Angeles. In addition, he is a partner in the Thornburgh Resort Company, responsible for developing the Tribute Golf Club and Resort land community in Bend, Oregon. Chapman rounds out his business expertise with five restaurants in California and Wyoming, and by providing residents and visitors to the Coachella Valley with private jet service operations, catering, aircraft storage, and concierge services through Tradition Aviation Fixed Based Operations.

Robert Stennett has been a business leader in the aerospace industry for the past 24 years with his last assignment as the director of Supply Chain Management for the F-22 program. A native of Shreveport, Louisiana, Stennett holds a bachelors degree in business from Louisiana State University in Shreveport and a Masters in Business Administration in Management from Louisiana Tech University. Stennett has accomplished post-graduate work and facilitated industry and academic partnerships in the areas of supply chain management, operations research, and strategic planning with the Wharton School of Business at the University of Pennsylvania, Clarkson University in Potsdam NY, and the Tepper School of Business at Carnegie Mellon University. As a member of Shady Oaks Country Club since 1984 and dependent member before that, he had the opportunity to observe Hogan for almost two decades before the legendary golfer passed away in 1997. Stennett served on the Board of Governors at Shady Oaks Country Club from 2001 to 2007 and is currently on the Community Outreach Committee of the First Tee of Fort Worth. He will also serve this year on the Northern Texas PGA Junior Golf Foundation's scholarship selection committee and is active in numerous other Fort Worth community and civic boards.
